Act passed in Charleston County. In celebration we will be showing *UNCONSTITUTIONAL: The War on Our Civil Liberties*, from Robert Greenwald. Following the movie, Will Moredock and Cookie Washington will speak and then we will have about 15 minutes for an open discussion. Drafts of a proposed resolution and petition will be offered as a possible starting point.

ThinkingPeople believes that the USA Patriot Act is one of the most **UN-PATRIOTIC** laws to be perpetrated on the American People in the history of our country and we are not alone! As of September 19th of this year, 7 state and 388 city and county resolutions to the U.S.A.P.A.T.R.I.O.T. Act have been passed representing over 62,000,000 American citizens.

Our goal is to raise awareness about the U.S.A.P.A.T.R.I.O.T. Act and encourage action amongst the citizens of our community. None of us are **exempt** or "**protected**" from the many ways the Patriot Act is being used by our government. If we are able to effectively unite around this issue locally, we can effect change locally and send a message nationally. **The Patriot Act has not only failed to protect our citizens it is being used as a weapon against them. It weakens us each as individuals and collectively as a nation.**
