“Homegrown Terrorism” Bills Threaten Liberties by:

Groups selected by the commission for study might not be involved in criminal activity, but can still be branded as “homegrown terrorists.”
- **TARGETING INNOCENT PEOPLE.** The bill creates a commission whose study may target certain groups as possible terrorists, just as the FBI has done since 9/11, which resulted in arrests and sting operations conducted in Muslim and Arab communities in the United States.
- **CREATING A COMMITTEE WITH UNCLEAR SCOPE.** The committee that this bill establishes would not be limited to studying violence. It would also study groups that use, plan, or threaten to use “force” to “intimidate or coerce the United States government ... in furtherance of political or social objectives.”
- **USING UNCLEAR LANGUAGE.** This bill does not define “extremist belief system,” leaving it open to political interpretation. As Reagan’s Assistant Secretary of the Treasury, Paul Craig Thomas, asked, “Who will be on the ‘extremist beliefs’ list?”

H.R. 1955 passed the House 404-6.
